REMINDERS

The board approved the 2026 budget. Starting January 1, 2026, the monthly fee due to the Association is \$633. Coupon books were sent to you. The final budget is on the website. In addition, the special assessment of \$230 is due in March. No coupons were printed for this assessment. Palm trees will be trimmed this spring.

Roofs will be blown off in the spring and tree trimming and/or removal is scheduled for first quarter of the year. And sometime soon, the perimeter wood fences will be replaced.

WANT SOD? TREES NEED ATTENTION?

The board is making lists. Please note that major budget funds were planned for sod in 2026, so if you are asking NOW, this may not happen in 2026. Your feedback was requested for several months prior to voting on a budget, so if you want sod, a new tree, or some other items, you need to request it prior to budget time before a budget is finalized. The board will arrange for our tree guy to inspect trees several times a year, and roofs are routinely inspected during blow offs (spring and fall). If you have made a request, the board will let you know what was decided and when it is expected to be fulfilled.
